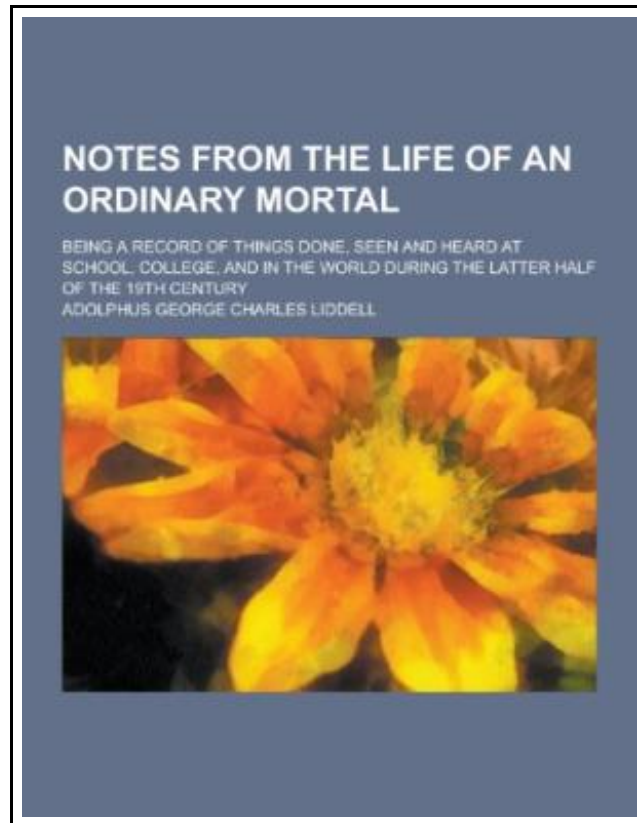

I met Matthew Arnold in Piccadilly and walked with him to St. James s Place. His talk was interesting, but his Dundreary manner is curious in a man of such austere intellectual taste. He said that Carlyle had never satisfied him. George Eliot s books he did not like, though he recognised her power of drawing character. He had no great opinion of Lowell as a poet, better as a critic. Thought Benjamin Franklin s autobiography very poor, Richard s Maxims the best American book. He had not been able to care much yet for Bret Harte, but thought he might do so; was going to read him to his daughters. Had lately re-read David Copperfield, and had liked it much more than he had ever done before, being struck with its vigorous talent. He had been more thanked for his last poem (on the death of the dog Geist) than for anything he ever wrote. He 1879-81 BURTON ON CARLYLE 191 supposed it was because few persons liked verses, and many liked dogs. I find noted in my diary under Feb. 25th of this year: At 12 this night Courts of Common Pleas and Exchequer breathed their last. This change, which saved a few thousands a year, has not, in my opinion, been followed with the good results expected by its authors. It has substituted for these Courts, each under the immediate control of its chief, an unwieldy body of Judges...
