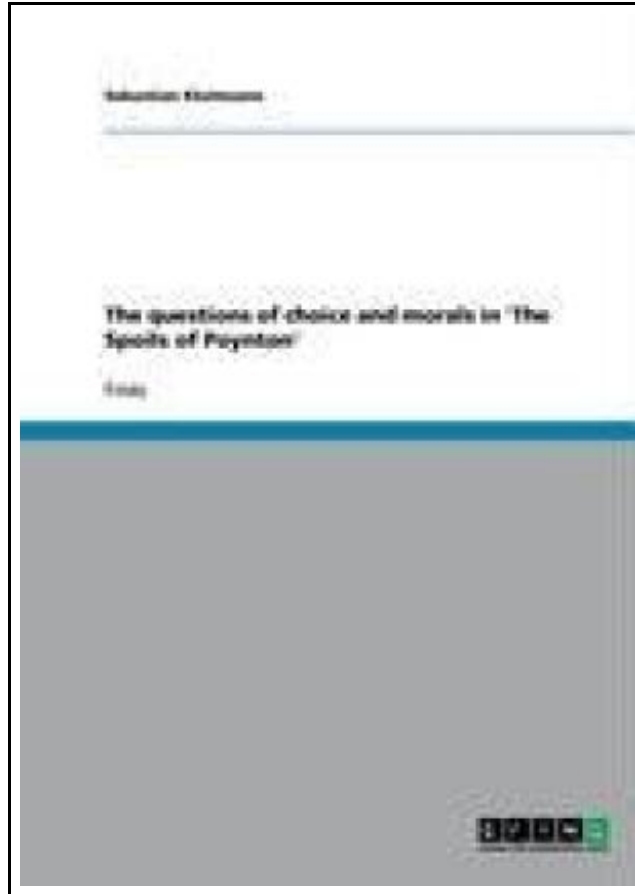

Introduction: 5). Both ways of interpretation actually imply that Fleda is indeed the free spirit James intended. This view is particularly clear in the wikipedia article which states that Fleda Vetch has earned most critics' sympathy for steering the right course through an almost impossible situation (Wikipedia). The talk of a right course , however, reveals the author s belief that Fleda has a choice. In the following, I want to argue that the exact opposite is the case. Fleda s actions are not based on moral considerations but rather on existential necessities. Her freedom is therefore restricted to the realm of her imagination; all other decisions are dictated by the expectations of society. This is also the one unifying force to which all characters are subject and due to his own disillusionment with existing English society (Lyons.
